Orange County Fire Authority to Participate in "Every 15 Minutes" Mock DUI Crash Event at Los Alamitos High School

- Who:** The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) will be one of several agencies participating in a Mock DUI crash at Los Alamitos High School. Participating agencies will include: OCFA, Los Alamitos PD, CARE Ambulance Service, and Mercy Air.
- What:** This event is designed to teach students the dangers of drinking and driving. This event will involve a simulated car crash with an overturned vehicle and the extrication of a trapped person by firefighters in a second car using the "Jaws of Life". Simulated scene treatment of patients with both traumatic and fatal injuries. Mercy Air will be landing a helicopter to transport a patient as well. Los Alamitos PD officers will demonstrate a simulated field sobriety test.
