## ***Kevin Woyjeck Memorial Highway Sign Unveiling Ceremony***

**What:** A highway sign in memory of Seal Beach resident and Granite Mountain Hotshot Firefighter Kevin Woyjeck will be unveiled at OCFA Fire Station 48 in Seal Beach.

A section of the 405 Freeway in Seal Beach will be named in honor of Woyjeck, one of 19 firefighters killed in the line of duty on June 30, 2013 while fighting a wildfire in Yarnell, Arizona. Woyjeck, 21, was a member of the elite hotshots based in Prescott, Arizona who specialize in fighting wildfires.
