TWIN TOWERS STEEL BEAM TO BE DEDICATED IN 9/11 CEREMONY

18th Anniversary of that Fateful Day

WHAT: The tragic events of September 11, 2001 should never be forgotten. On this 18th anniversary of the horrific attacks of 9/11, OCFA will mark the day by dedicating a steel beam from the World Trade Center. The five foot beam that was donated to OCFA will sit predominately in the lobby of the Regional Fire Operations Training Center. It will serve as a reminder of the 2,977 men, women and children who were killed in the attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and aboard Flight 93. Close to the heart of OCFA, is the 343 firefighters who perished while trying to save the lives of others. Following a brief dedication, the annual day of remembrance ceremony will be held.
