**Who:** Orange County Fire Authority Fire Chief Keith Richter along with Orange County

Supervisor Third District Todd Spitzer and Tustin Mayor Al Murray to dedicate and

reveal the new, state-of-the-art Fire Station 37 in Tustin.

**What:** Dedication with ribbon-cutting on this high-tech facility that is 10,000 square feet

with eight dorm rooms and three apparatus bays. Fire Station 37, located at the corner of Edinger and Kensington, sits on a one-acre site in the Tustin Legacy development. The new station will respond to the Tustin Legacy and Columbus Grove developments as well as the area around the District. Fire Station 37 is LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified that means it assists building owners and operators to be environmentally responsible and use resources more efficiently. Engine Company 37 will have a Paramedic Assessment

Unit (PAU) comprised of one Captain, one Fire Apparatus Engineer, and one Firefighter/Paramedic, with room to expand both personnel and equipment to

meet the future needs of the community.
