OCFA Academy #43 Will Graduate 36 Firefighters

Irvine, CA –The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) will graduate 36 new firefighters from their fire academy during a ceremony on March 15, 2017 at 6 p.m. The graduation will take place at OCFA's Regional Fire Operations and Training Center (RFOTC), 1 Fire Authority Road, Irvine.

Buena Park Mayor Elizabeth Swift, who also serves as the chair of OCFA's Board of Directors, will be the keynote speaker.
