Orange County Fire Authority to Participate in Mock DUI Crash Event at San Clemente High School

Who: The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) will be one of several agencies participating in

a mock DUI crash at San Clemente High School. Participating agencies will include: OCFA, OCSD, CHP, Friends Against Drinking and Driving (FADD), Mission Hospital, Trauma Intervention Program (TIP), O'Connor Mortuary, Care Ambulance, and S & K Towing.

What: This event is designed to teach students the dangers of drinking and driving. This event will involve a simulated car crash with an overturned vehicle the extrication of a trapped

person in a second car by firefighters using the "Jaws of Life". There will also be simulated scene treatment of patients with both traumatic and fatal injuries. Law enforcement

officers will also demonstrate a simulated field sobriety test.

"It is a very realistic and powerful event for all the students, faculty and parents watching. This is a very important message that can save lives," says Captain Steve Concialdi. "We hope the students learn from other student's mistakes and not drink and drive." Captain
