Family Rescued by OCFA & Garden Grove Firefighters to Meet At Fire Station 78

Who: Crews from the Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) and the Garden Grove Fire

Department will be reunited with individuals that were rescued from a structure fire that

occurred on March 11th, 2017 in Santa Ana.

What: OCFA and Garden Grove Fire agencies responded to a well involved structure fire, located

on the 4800 block of W. Morningside Avenue, in the city of Santa Ana. While fighting the fire, they were able to rescue a 15-year-old girl and her stepfather. Unfortunately, the mother was lost to the fire. The two survivors have asked to meet the firefighters that

rescued them that night.
