Orange County Fire Authority Installing Free Smoke Alarms in Santa Ana

- **Who:** The Orange County Fire Authority, City of Santa Ana, and the Red Cross will partner together to install free smoke alarms and work with residents to be prepared to act should a fire occur.
- **What:** Starting at the Santa Ana Church, volunteers will go door to door to ask residents if they would like free smoke alarms installed in their homes that day. Residents will receive information for fire safety and preparedness, and will learn how to create a home evacuation plan.
