


MAXIMUM VOLUNTARY CONSECUTIVE HOURS WORKED FROM 120 TO 144

Term of the Agreement: August 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020

The Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) and the Orange County Fire Authority Chief Officers Association (COA) hereby mutually enter into this agreement to extend the current maximum voluntary consecutive hours worked from 120 to 144 hours. Upon reaching 144 hours, employees must take at least 24 hours off duty before returning to work. The ability to force employees up to 96 hours remains in effect.


